Covid Safety Guidelines for Re Opening

General Guidelines

~Children will have their temperature taken before they enter the hallway of the preschool.

~Any child with a temperature higher than 99.9 will not be allowed to attend school on that day.

~Parents will wear a mask for drop off and pick up. Masks should be:

Made of cotton(cloth) and be multiple layers

Fit snugly against the side of the face

Be secured with ties or ear loops

~Unfortunately, we are not allowed to have parents volunteer at this time because of COVID and the necessary restrictions.

~Drop off and pick up times will be staggered to maintain a limited number of people at one given time. Age group times will be given to parents before the first day of school

Classroom Guidelines

~All classrooms will maintain a capacity of no more than 9 children.

~Students must either wash their hands with soap and water or use hand sanitizer before entering the classroom upon arrival.

~Children four (4) years and older will be encouraged to wear a mask, but will not be forced to wear one.

~Sensory Tables will be closed and not used until permission is granted from the state level.

~Children will be spaced out during lunch time to ensure safety while eating. No food will be shared.

~Children will wash their hands with soap and water after recess and before lunch.

~Children will have their own supplies in a labeled bag and used only by that student.

~If a child should develop any COVID related symptoms during the school day, parents will be called to come pick their child up. It is recommended that the student be tested. If the student tests positive, they must isolate at home for 10 days from the date of the test and be fever free for three days before returning to school.

The guidelines listed herein are directly from the New Mexico Department of Health and The New Mexico Early Childhood Education and Care Department. PHUMC Preschool will follow and mandate the guidelines to ensure the health and safety of all students, staff, and families enrolled at our center.

We encourage all parents to assist the preschool in following all the guidelines while on our campus.
